Background

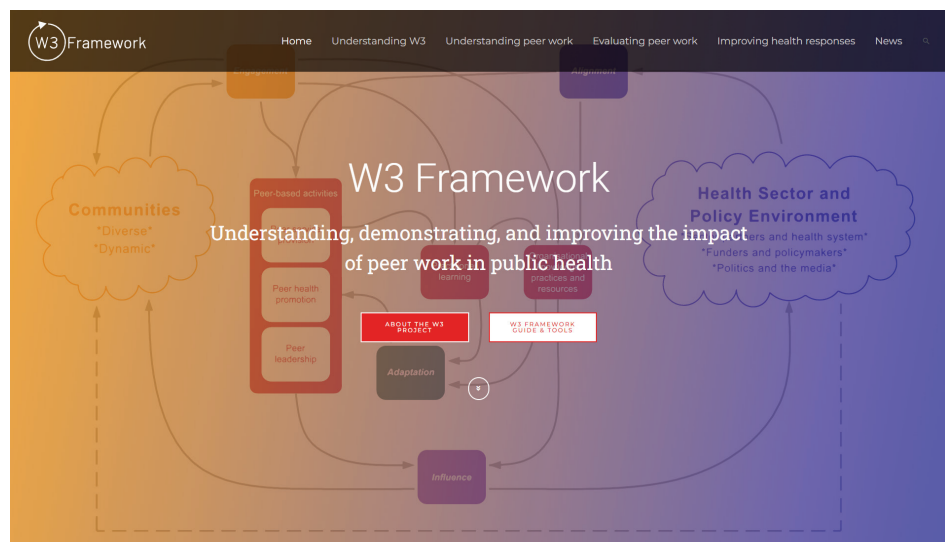
- Meaningful involvement of peers is a foundation of effective HIV responses
- Traditional evaluation methods do not capture peer work's full impact

Approach

- Collaboration with peer-led organisations
- Meaningful involvement of peer leaders
- Systems thinking

Outcomes and impact

- Practical resources to help peer responses:
 - Design and conduct effective evaluations of their work
 - Translate peer insights into organisational knowledge



Innovation and significance

- To the best of our knowledge, these are the first peer practitioner resources that:
 - Tailor evaluation processes to the unique way peer work operates
 - Explicitly look at the impact and influence peer work has within the broader health sector and policy environment
 - Include converting peer knowledge and insights into useful evidence for the health sector
